

2022 DOG AND CAT COSTUME CONTEST RULES & DETAILS

Description: Let your faithful companion join in the fun by entering your dog in this year's Canine Costume Contest! Come on out with your dog and let Irvington learn just how adorable your costumed cutie can be!

For our feline friends, we will have an online contest and voting. Put that puss in boots and let them shine like the star they are!

Canine Costume Contest:

Registration:

- Day of the Street Fair, October 29, 2022.
- Specific location at Street Fair still TBD
- Registration begins at 1:00pm and the final registration deadline is 2:45pm owner and dog MUST be in judging area by 3:00pm sharp!

Entry Fee: FREE

Contest Details:

- There will be TWO Categories for the Costume Contest: Adult/Dog and Child/Dog.
- Entrants must be leashed and present at the Street Fair.
- All canine entrants must be up to date of with canine vaccines and must be able to provide proof of vaccination upon request.
- Entries must be submitted no later than 2:45pm. Judging begins promptly at 3:00 pm.
- Participant's number must be pinned to the owner and visible to the judges.
- Participants and dogs are encouraged to be a part of the Marty Powell Costume Parade!
 - The Parade will begin at 4:00pm.
- Winners in both canine and feline categories will be announced from the main stage after the parade is complete (~5pm)
- The winning dog(s) will pose for a photo. Winners' name and photo will be included in our post-event press releases and on our website, and on future promotional events.

Contest Rules:

 Only dogs are eligible to enter the contest. No other animals will be allowed in the judging area.



- All dogs must remain leashed and with an adult as all times.
- Dog that are not well-behaved will be disqualified and asked to leave.
 - Determination of "well-behaved" is at the sole discretion of the judges.
- No puppies under 4 months or without vaccinations.
- Rabies and vaccinations must be current.
- Dogs must wear I.D. tags at all times.
- No dogs in heat.
- No aggressive dogs.
- Please pick up after your dog.
- Costumes must be safe and comfortable for dogs.

Failure to abide by any of these rules will result in disqualification with dog(s) and owner(s) being asked to leave the area.

Judging Criteria:

- Entrants will be judged on costume and behavior for creativity, humor, character, charisma, uniqueness and talent.
- Matching human and dog costumes are encouraged.
- The judges' decisions will be final.

Cat Online-Costume Contest:

Registration:

- Your photo with contact information must be emailed/submitted to info@irvingtonhalloween.com or form. by October 17th, 2022 at 5PM to be considered. Any photo posted to the event page by a contestant will be removed.
- All photos will be reviewed for appropriateness and will be posted for voting on October 24th. Appropriateness will be determined at the sole discretion of the Contest Manager, and is not subject to appeal.

Entry Fee: FREE

Contest Details:

- There will be TWO Categories for the Costume Contest: Cat(s) and Kitten(s). The term kitten means a cat younger than 1 year of age.
- Photos will be posted to the event page, with the top five from each category receiving the most "likes" moving to the final Judging.



- Judging is based solely on the photo submitted, live judging will NOT OCCUR.
- Winners in both canine and feline categories will be announced from the main stage after the parade is complete (~5pm)
- Winners' name and photo will be included in our post-event press releases and on our website, and on future promotional events.

Contest Rules:

- Only cats are eligible to enter the contest. While your feline friend can have a non-cat compadre, non-feline animals will not be considered during judging.
- Costumes must be safe and comfortable for cats.
- Animals may not be placed in unsafe or uncomfortable situations.
- Images must be submitted in JPEG, TIFF, or PDF. Inappropriately formatted photos will be reformatted at the discretion of the Contest Manager (meaning every attempt will be taken, but she's no IT department).

Failure to abide by any of these rules will result in disqualification of cat(s) contestants.

Judging Criteria:

- Entrants will be judged on costume and behavior for creativity, humor, character, charisma, uniqueness and talent.
- Matching human and cat costumes are encouraged.
- The judges' decisions will be final.
